## 146/15 WILTSHIRE COUNCIL – VARIATION OF CLUB CERTIFICATE – THE NORTH STAR CLUB

Members noted and supported the variation.

## 147/15 PUBLIC CONVENIENCES – THE PIPPIN

Members agreed that as we are trying to promote tourism and visitors to the town centre we should not be removing necessary facilities such as public toilets. These are the only facilities in the town centre currently.

Members discussed the costs involved in the process and the Town Clerk confirmed that whilst £9,000 has been factored in for cleaning, the Town Council could reduce the costs of cleaning the facility by delivering this service in house using our existing workforce. It was suggested that if we are to consider taking ownership, we may wish to consider installing additional signage as the toilets are currently not very well signed. We may also wish to consider spending a little more money initially, to upgrade the toilets themselves, as they are currently not of a particularly good standard.

The Town Clerk confirmed that there may be an opportunity to incorporate public toilets as part of the town centre Masterplan and/or the Town Hall and Heritage Quarter project. However in the interim, members agreed that we need to keep these toilets going for the benefit of the community and visitors to the town.

It was proposed by Councillor Hill, seconded by Councillor Widger and

**UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED** to recommend to Full Council that the Town Council take on ownership of the Public Conveniences at The Pippin, as part of a Community Asset Transfer and that the funds are vired from the General Reserves.

## 148/15 CALNE COMMUNITY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN STEERING GROUP

## 149/15 FESTIVE LIGHTING DISPLAYS

Members discussed the benefits for both hire and purchase options but generally agreed that a hire scheme allowed for more flexibility and would negate the need for us to store the equipment ourselves etc.
